

DryMed[®] Washable incontinence solutions 01.2018

Care and use instructions

Please read before use!

Indications for use

- For hygienic reasons, DryMed® washable incontinence products must be washed before using.
- Please fold the DryMed[®] incontinence diapers' hook-and-loop fastener together to avoid damages of their delicate inside caused by the hook-and-loop fasteners.
- For a complete cleaning of DryMed® incontinence products, it is advisable to wash the products inside out.
- Please dry and store DryMed[®] incontinence products inside out to guarantee the evaporation of any residual humidity.
- DryMed® incontinence products are manufactured in usual ready-to-wear garment sizes.
- While using DryMed[®] incontinence diaper, please pay attention that hook of fastener do not scratch the skin, which will otherwise cause skin irritations.
- Furthermore, it is important to avoid folds at legs' and hips' surrounding when DryMed[®] incontinence products are worn. This is to avoid liquid leakage.
- To avoid risk of asphyxiation, please keep the packaging bag away from children.

Term of use

- After soiling with faeces and/or urine, DryMed[®] incontinence products should be changed at least after four hours. It is advisable to change the products immediately after using.
- Even without draggling, DryMed[®] incontinence products should be changed at least after four hours.

Care instructions

DryMed[®] incontinence products can be washed with usual detergents in the washing machine. Please do not use fabric softeners otherwise the absorbing volume of product will be reduced.

Temperature: Laundering up to 95°C is possible. For ecologic and economic reasons, washing temperature of 60°C is adequate and advisable.

Whitening: Please, do not use chlorine; the waterproof PU-covering will be damaged and loses its

Laundry dryer: The dryer temperatures are not allowed to exceed 90°C.



Ironing: Please, do not iron; the sensible surface will be destroyed by direct heat.

By following written instructions, DryMed[®] incontinence products can be worn and washed up to 300 times without losing their characteristics.

Storing Advice

- * Products should not be stored over 90°C.
- * Products must not be in contact with open fire.
- * Please avoid direct contact to other heat sources (heating element support etc).
